

## WRBLSA PROGRAMMING



Each year, WRBLSA carries out programming that fulfills our mission to equip students with the skills necessary to succeed academically and professionally. In addition, our members actively engage with the community and take part in our Nation's legal and political discourse.

#### **Career Fair Program**

WRBLSA hosts a job fair during the summer prior to the academic year to provide our members with opportunities to interview with top firms and to provide firms with a unique opportunity to speak to and recruit diverse talent from law schools across the nation.

Beginning in 2018, WRBLSA hosts this Gala to extend its appreciation to sponsors, acknowledge legal community leaders and highlight scholarship recipients.


#### PRE-LAW STUDENT DIVISION
